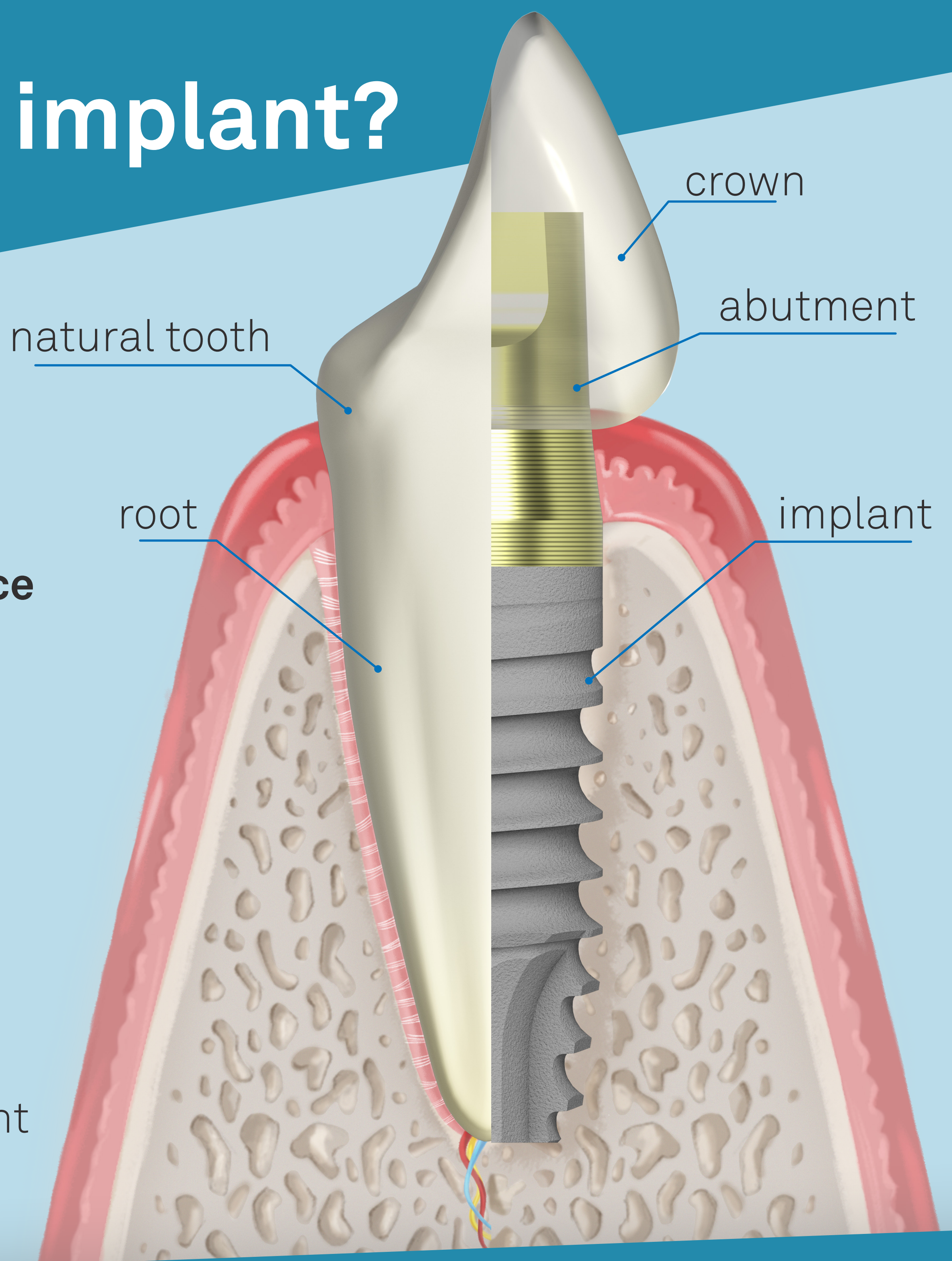


What is an implant?

An implant is a screw inserted in the upper or lower jaw by the dentist to **replace the natural root of a lacking tooth**.

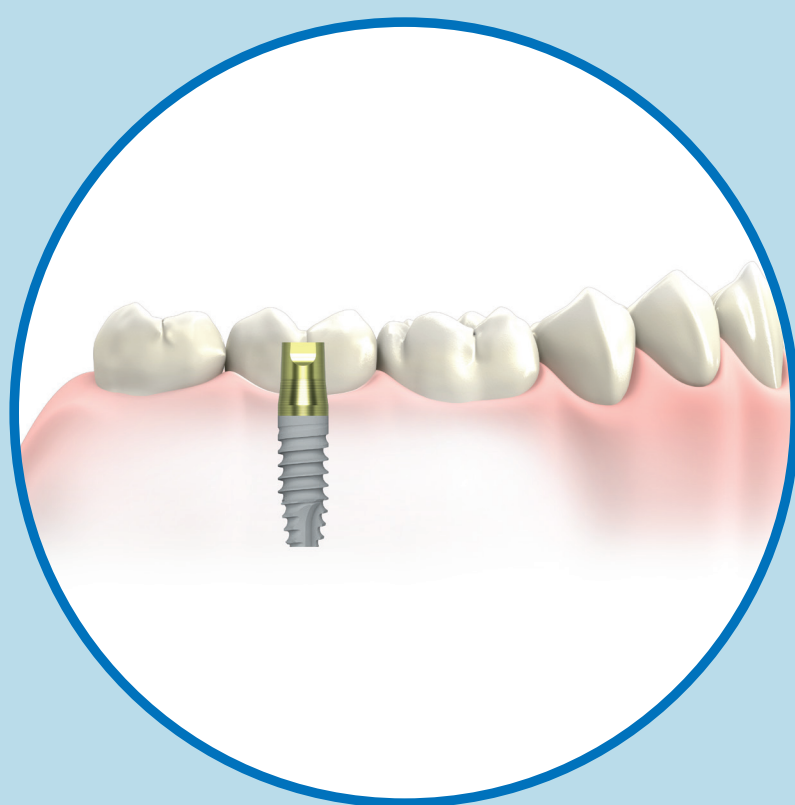
Once the **implant** is inserted, the bone adheres to it and grows around it.

The **abutment** is tightened to the implant to support the **crown**.

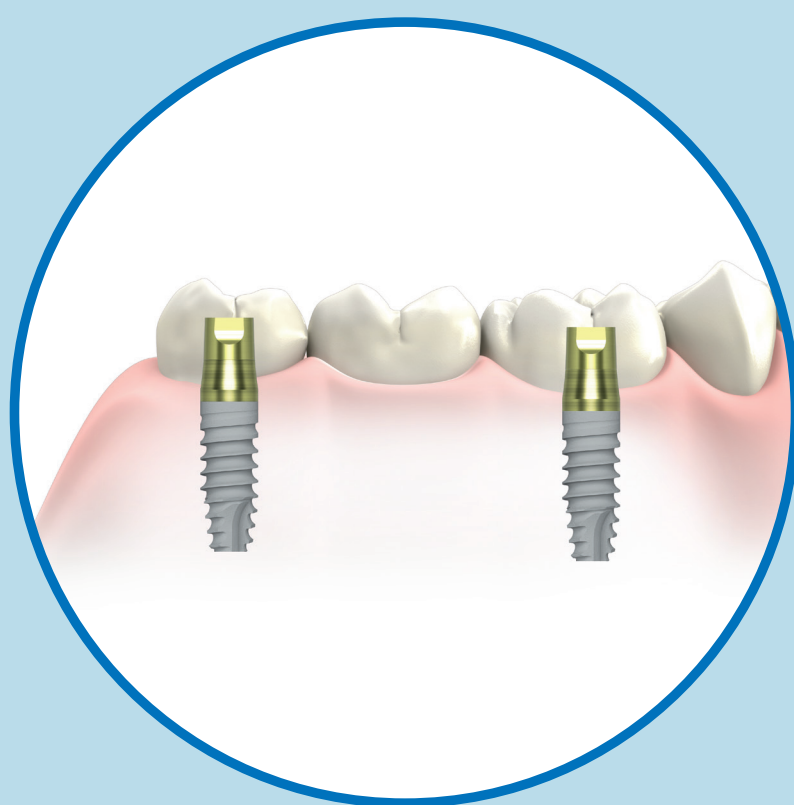


Implants are made of medical titanium, a highly biocompatible material well accepted by human body. They can replace:

A single tooth



More than one tooth



A full arch
